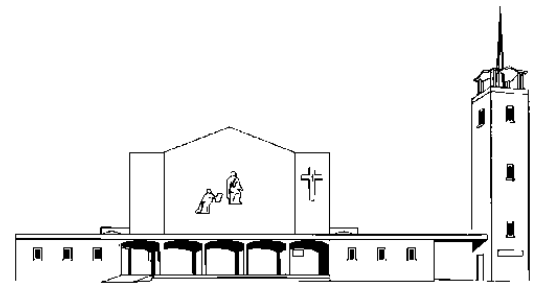

GOSPEL: John 20: 19-23

*As the Father sent me, so am I sending you: receive the Holy Spirit.*

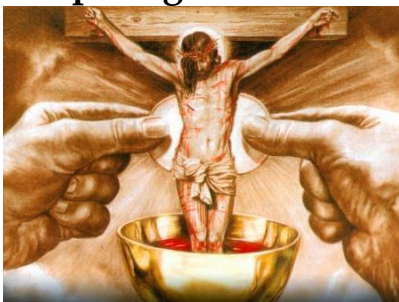

**REGARDING THE CRYPT'S RE-FIT:** As I said last week, we are getting nearer to the completion of the re-fit of the crypt kitchen, and I am grateful for your patience, as the work on flooring, damp-treatment, electrics, and new units and appliances has taken since mid-February. We have now taken delivery of the units and appliances, and fitting will begin this week. We have already received one generous donation towards the new kitchen, but if any other parishioners wish to contribute to the costs (which total £18,000), then it will be gratefully welcomed. The new kitchen will last us well in to the future!

Lastly, the Church is apostolic in the sense that she "continues to be taught, sanctified and guided by the Apostles until Christ's return, through their successors in pastoral office: the college of Bishops assisted by priests, in union with the Successor of Peter, the Church's supreme pastor." Succession to the Apostles in the pastoral mission necessarily entails the sacrament of Holy Orders, that is, the uninterrupted sequence, from the very beginning, of valid episcopal ordinations. This succession is essential for the Church to exist in a proper and full sense. The Eucharist also expresses this sense of apostolicity. As the Second

Vatican Council teaches, "the faithful join in the offering of the Eucharist by virtue of their royal priesthood", yet it is the ordained priest who, "acting in the person of Christ, brings about the Eucharistic Sacrifice and offers it to God in the name of all the people."

Our fundraising began in 2014, and we have pledged of c. £185k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £51k. So far we already have £27k available for our parish project, which is to employ a part-time worker in the area of catechetics and evangelization.

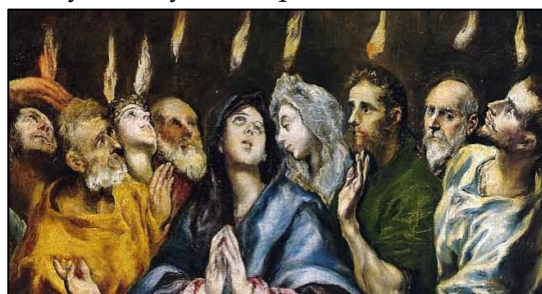
