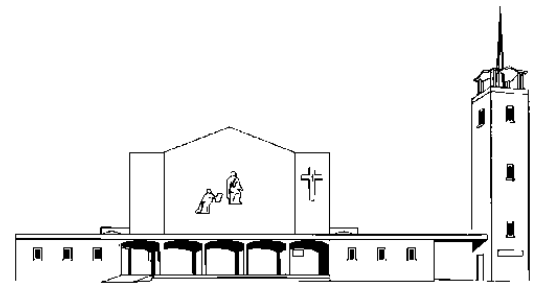

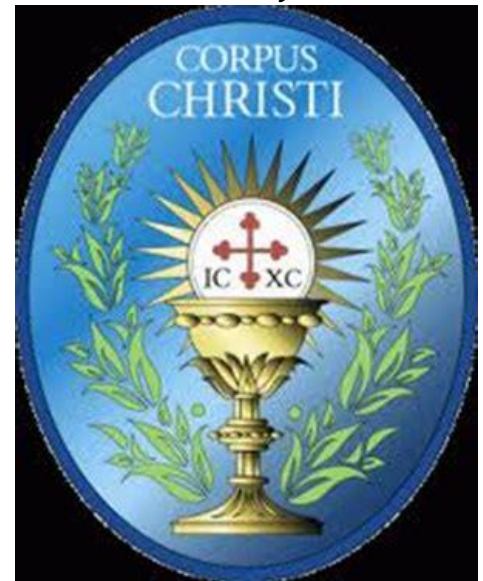
My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

ANOTHER OF THE BEAUTIFUL FEASTS AFTER EASTER is celebrated today – **the Body and Blood of the Lord**. This most blessed Sacrament, Our Divine Lord's abiding presence in the Holy Eucharist, is His precious gift, given on the vigil of His Passion and Death. It contains within it the salvation of the world, for it is truly the saving Sacrifice "for the life of the world."

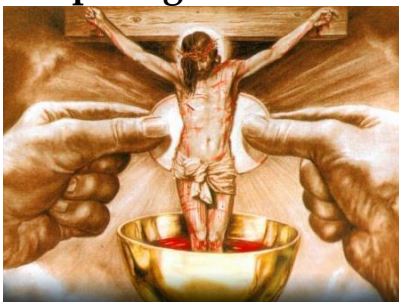
THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS in Liverpool in September will have an attendance from this parish of about 8 including myself, and nearer the time we will have a commissioning of our representatives. This will be an event of national importance to us as Catholics – a way of expressing our deepest devotion to Jesus our Lord in of His Body & Blood. Last time England & Wales held a Eucharistic Congress (1908), the state forbade us from organising a *Corpus Christi* Procession – this time, a century on, thank God, there will be a wonderful Procession in honour of the Blessed Sacrament!

We, too, will have our special time of **40 Hours' Adoration** (Friday to Sunday) and **Corpus Christi Procession** at the end of the month, beginning on the feast of SS Peter & Paul (29th). Please see the rota for spending time in Adoration (half-hour slots) which is now already available on the blue board in the church porch. Everyone should organise a little bit of time to contribute to this powerful 40 Hours of parish prayer before Jesus.

May the Lord, truly present in the Eucharist, fill you with blessings at Mass today! Fr Philip



Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 30:



The Catholic Church's teaching on the relationship between priestly ministry and the Eucharist and her teaching on the Eucharistic Sacrifice have both been the subject in recent decades of a fruitful dialogue *in the area of ecumenism*. We must give thanks to the Blessed Trinity for the significant progress and convergence achieved in this regard, which lead us to hope one day for a full sharing of faith. Nonetheless, the observations of the Council concerning the Ecclesial Communities which arose in the West from the sixteenth century onwards and are separated from the Catholic Church remain fully pertinent: "The Ecclesial

Communities separated from us lack that fullness of unity with us which should flow from Baptism, and we believe that especially because of the lack of the sacrament of Orders they have not preserved the genuine and total reality of the Eucharistic mystery. Nevertheless, when they commemorate the Lord's death and resurrection in the Holy Supper, they profess that it signifies life in communion with Christ and they await his coming in glory."

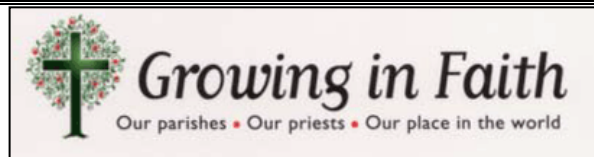
CATECHETICS

CONFIRMATION 2019: an initial meeting date for the coming year's programme will soon be announced, so please 'watch this space'!

"RCIA" - 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion). **The course will begin Monday, 3rd September at 7pm**. If anyone is considering becoming a Catholic (or is an adult Catholic wishing to be confirmed,) please contact Fr Philip as soon as possible. Our fundraising began in 2014, and **we have pledged of c. £185k, to give our parish project, ultimately, a slice of c. £51k**. So far we already have £27k available for our parish project, which is to employ a part-time worker in the area of catechetics and evangelization.

Fr Philip is working with the diocese and seeking advice from other diocesan priests to draw up a job description to find the right person for this role.
