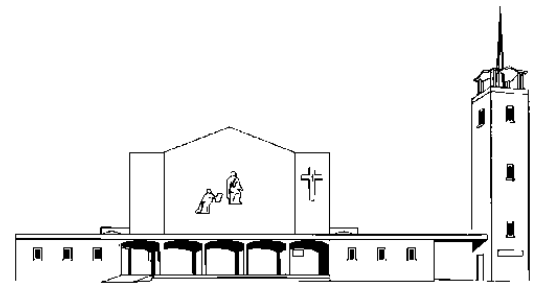

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

THE SUNDAY GOSPEL SPEAKS OF THE MISSION OF THE APOSTLES to preach the Good News amongst the towns and villages. Included alongside their preaching of repentance, and their liberating from demonic possession, was the anointing with oil. This latter apostolic action has come down to us as the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**. It is about this that I will be preaching this weekend, as it is a beautiful and powerful Sacrament, but

maybe little-appreciated or misunderstood even amongst practising Catholics. It's important that we are better informed about this healing Sacrament, so that we make sure that we call the priest to our frail or seriously ill relatives – or for ourselves – when necessary.

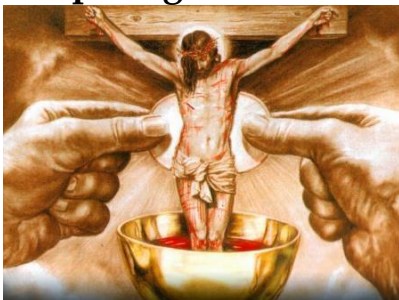

Preparing for the Eucharistic Congress 2018: John Paul II's *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 36:



Invisible communion, though by its nature always growing, presupposes the life of grace, by which we become "partakers of the divine nature," and the practice of the virtues of faith, hope and love. ... Keeping these invisible bonds intact is a specific moral duty incumbent upon Christians who wish to participate fully in the Eucharist by receiving the body and blood of Christ. The Apostle Paul appeals to this duty when he warns: "Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup." Along these same lines, the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* rightly stipulates that "anyone conscious of a grave sin must receive the sacrament of Reconciliation before coming to communion". I therefore desire to reaffirm that in the Church there remains in force, now and in the future, the rule by which the Council of Trent gave concrete expression to the Apostle Paul's stern warning when it affirmed that, in order to receive the Eucharist in a worthy manner, "one must first confess one's sins, when one is aware of mortal sin."
