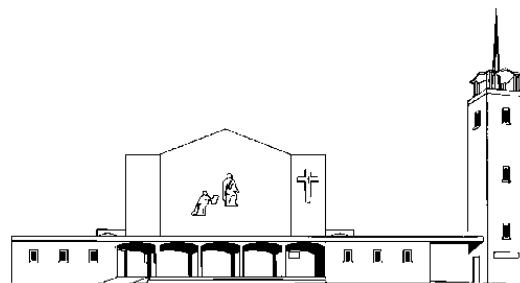

**GOSPEL: John 10: 27-30**

*I give eternal life to the sheep that belong to me.*

**My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,**

**MAY IS THE MONTH OF MARY!** We honour her in a particular way this month, though naturally our prayers invoking her intercession and our reliance on her maternal help are daily, all-year-round.

Mary of Nazareth, the one chosen by God from all women in history to be the Mother of the incarnate Son of God, is of course to be honoured. The choosing of her is God's own choice, not ours – so giving her the respect that we do as Christians is to echo the greeting God made to her through the angel, "Hail, full of grace!"



I dearly encourage you therefore to pray the Rosary daily this month. As a parish we pray a decade before each Sunday Mass this month. Additionally I want to invite you to the following three expressions of our love for, and our reliance on, Mary, Mother of all Christians:

- The May Procession this weekend (**Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May at 5pm**) in which we process a statue of Our Lady and honour her with the Rosary, hymns and prayers;
- The parish day pilgrimage (this **Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> May**) to Aylesford ([www.thefriars.org.uk](http://www.thefriars.org.uk)), the Carmelite shrine to Our Lady of Mt Carmel, which dates back to 1242. We will depart Hoddesdon on the coach at 9am, and spend a quiet day in the tranquil surrounds of Aylesford Priory, with Mass, lunch, and the Rosary. If you have never been to Aylesford before, then think of coming, as it is a truly special place of prayer and the presence of Our Blessed Mother.
- A new series of talks by myself on the theme of Mary, drawing on a book ("Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary") by the same author as the Eucharist talks I gave last year. See the flyer available, and note the dates allocated: **8pm on Tuesdays 21<sup>st</sup> May, 18<sup>th</sup> June, 16<sup>th</sup> July.**

**May the Mother of Jesus pray for us to be renewed in holiness! Fr Philip**

**St Augustine teaches: Sermon for Catechumens on the Creed, 15**

When you have been baptized, hold fast a good life in the commandments of God, that you may guard your Baptism even unto the end. I do not tell you that you will live here without sin; but they are venial, without which this life is not. For the sake of all sins was Baptism provided; for the sake of light sins, without which we cannot be, was prayer provided. ... Once for all we have washing in Baptism, every day we have washing in prayer. Only, do not commit those things for which you must needs be separated from Christ's body: which be far from you! For those whom you have seen doing penance, have committed heinous things, either adulteries or some enormous crimes: for these they do penance.



## PRAYER & LITURGY

**MONTH OF OUR LADY:** During May, a decade of the Rosary will be prayed for before each Sunday Mass.

**ANNUAL MAY PROCESSION** will be held **this Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May** starting in the Church at 5pm, ending in the Grotto in the garden. This will be a service of the rosary, hymns and prayers in honour of our Blessed Lady. Tea and cakes will be available afterwards. **Volunteers are needed to make the refreshments – if you can help, please contact the presbytery.**

### **AYLESFORD PRIORY PILGRIMAGE DAY**

Fr Philip will lead a group to the Marian Carmelite Shrine at Aylesford (Kent) for a day out on **Thurs 16<sup>th</sup> May, leaving the church at 9am.** We'll arrive for midday Mass in cloister chapel; lunch in pilgrims' Hall; follow the rosary way and have Benediction, departing after tea at about 4pm. The total cost (incl. the coach) is £35, and we are given a hot 3-course lunch in the mediaeval Pilgrims' Hall. **If you would like to go, please complete the slip at the bottom of the newsletter and return it to the presbytery, together with your money by MONDAY 13<sup>th</sup> MAY 12 noon, as numbers need to be confirmed. There are still 16 spaces available.**
