

## My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

MAY IS THE MONTH OF MARY! We honour her in a particular way this month, through special devotions, although naturally our prayers invoking her intercession and our reliance on her maternal help are daily, all-year-round. I dearly encourage you therefore to pray the Rosary daily this month. As a parish we pray a decade before each Sunday Mass this month. Additionally I want to invite you to the following three-talk series on the Jewish roots of our Catholic beliefs and practices with regard to Mary. These will take place in the church over the next three months on Tuesdays at 8pm:


