

2019/20 Year of the Word: Pope Benedict XVI, Verbum Domini, n. 6

The Johannine Prologue [Jn 1:1–14] makes us realize that the *Logos* is truly *eternal*, and from eternity *is himself God*. God was never without his *Logos*. "The Word" exists before creation. Consequently at the heart of the divine life there is communion, there is absolute gift. "God is love," as the same Apostle tells us elsewhere, thus pointing to "the Christian image of God and the resulting image of mankind and its destiny". God makes himself known to us as a mystery of infinite love in which the Father eternally utters his Word in the Holy Spirit. Consequently the Word, who from the beginning is with God and is God, reveals God himself in the dialogue of love between the divine persons, and invites us to share in that love. Created in the image and likeness of the God who is love,

we can thus understand ourselves only in accepting the Word and in docility to the work of the Holy Spirit. In the light of the revelation made by God's Word, the enigma of the human condition is definitively clarified.
