GOSPEL: John 11: 1-45

I am the resurrection and the life.

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

I PRAY THAT YOU ARE KEEPING SAFE AND WELL during this period of unprecedented restrictions on our national and Catholic life. We all know how important it is to make the sacrifices that we are, to keep as many people – not least the older and frailer members of society – free from the virus outbreak. Be assured that Fr Joshy & I are keeping a fervent routine of prayers offered in our church – despite its being closed to you – and are including you in the daily Mass and prayers. In general, he &/or I offer an 8am Mass, followed by 8.30-10am Adoration; and a 2nd Holy Hour in the evening 6-7pm. When a second Mass is scheduled (Sat/Sun) then he or I offer that in the evening. We pray the Pope's prayer to Our Lady (see inside) twice a day. Please join your daily prayers to ours, from the safety of your home.

A local church, St Joseph & English Martyrs in Bishops Stortford, has Mass streamed online in high-quality audio & video every day. Sunday Mass there can be followed at <http://www.churchservices.tv/bishopsstortford> at 6pm Sat; 9am, 11am & 6pm Sunday. Another excellent alternative is to follow Mass live from the basilica at Walsingham: <https://www.walsingham.org.uk/>. **This Sunday, 29th March** is the national day of **Re-dedication of England to Our Lady, at around midday**: PLEASE take part in this, in your homes and families, to re-dedicate our land to Our Blessed Mother, and implore her motherly intercession, using the prayers available [here](#). It could not come at a more crucial time for us all.

An excellent resource, shared to our parish [FaceBook](#) page every day, is www.lentinisolation.com which presents the daily Scripture readings, an excellent reflection from a priest, followed by the recitation of an '[Act of Spiritual Communion](#).'

FOLLOWING OUR RECENT 'PLANNED GIVING' CAMPAIGN – for which, once again, I

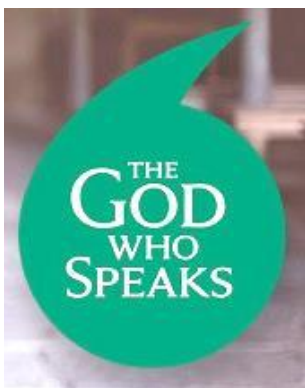

PRAYER & LITURGY

LITURGY DURING THE PUBLIC SUSPENSION OF MASS: all the public ceremonies have had to be suspended. Mass will be celebrated by Fr Joshy & Fr Philip in private, and they will be praying for the needs of the parish in their twice-daily Holy Hours with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

- The suspension of public Mass by the bishop means that the *obligation to attend Sunday Mass is removed* for the duration of the suspension.
- *All the parish Masses*, for the intentions requested, will be offered without fail, even though in private. Please continue to ask for Masses to be offered, and these will be published in the Newsletter as usual.
- *Mass can be followed online* at the church of St Joseph & English Martyrs, Bishops Stortford (<http://www.churchservices.tv/bishopstortford>) at the following times: Saturday 6pm; Sunday 9am, 11am, 6pm; and weekdays 9.30am. Or at midday at the Walsingham shrine <https://www.walsingham.org.uk/>. This is not an obligation, but would be a pious practice in order to stay in touch with the rhythm of the Church's seasons and her devotional life.

LENT

DESPITE the suspension of public Mass, we can still exercise fervent Lenten disciplines.

Prayer: e.g. Following **Mass online** (see front page of Newsletter); reading our pocket copies of **St Matthew's Gospel** 'day by day'; **Stations of the Cross** (privately, at home); **Rosary**.

Fasting: e.g. refraining from meat on extra day(s) in the week, not just Friday; 'giving up' some of the classic treats such as sugar, cakes, chocolate, alcohol; fasting from the use of TV, social media, internet, etc.

Almsgiving: e.g. **Broxbourne FoodBank** (collection box in PRESBYTERY – ring the doorbell); establishing a '**Charity account**' with C.A.F. for regular charitable giving.

Reconciliation: in case of real necessity, contact Fr Philip for an appointment which would probably have to take place in the parish garden, exercising due distance.

FINANCE

THANK YOU to those parishioners who took part in the recent appeal with regard to 'planned giving.' Almost all those cards which were filled out to set up Standing Orders have already been delivered to the relevant banks. A few signatures etc. were missing, which will be followed up when possible. This is a vital contribution that you are making to our parish finances at this time.

We have a number of parishioners offering to assist with shopping or running errands for anyone who is self-isolating, or elderly and choosing to remain safely at home. CATECHETICS

"RCIA" - 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' is the programme for preparation for adults wishing to become Catholics, or be prepared for the Sacraments of Initiation. The meetings have been suspended for the time being, and those being prepared for Reception into the Catholic Church, and Confirmation, at Easter, will be received and confirmed as soon as is reasonably possible when the current restrictions are lifted.

CONFIRMATION 2020: classes suspended for now. Sadly, the celebration of Confirmation is unlikely to take place on 26th April.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION COURSE has been suspended for the time being.

JUSTICE & PEACE & PRO-LIFE

CORONAVIRUS - FOODBANK: In light of the uncertainty over the Coronavirus, it is understandable that we want to ensure our kitchen cupboards are well stocked. However, we must not forget that this can leave foodbanks struggling. Hundreds of people rely

on generous donations from our parishioners. This includes the need for hygiene items, toilet paper, sanitary products etc., as well as sealed packages of dry food, tins, and long-life milk etc. PLEASE BRING ANY ITEMS FOR THE FOODBANK TO THE PRESBYTERY FRONT DOOR – as long as Fr Philip is in, he will add them to the FoodBank box which is now moved to the Presbytery entrance hall.
