My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

CARDINAL VINCENT & THE OTHER ENGLISH BISHOPS, following the Bill passed in Parliament last Wednesday, have accepted the guidance of Government, and once again suspended the public liturgy of the Church for 28 days till Wed 2nd Dec. inclusive. The <u>letter to the Catholic community</u> is included in your Newsletter today. It is a great sadness that once again I am unable to celebrate the daily Mass with you all, but be assured that Fr Joshy & I will be celebrating all the Masses requested, including the daily Mass intention in November for the Holy Souls, your departed loved ones whose names you have submitted



and which lie on the altar. Let us be close in prayer for one another despite this situation!

THE CHURCH IS NOT CLOSED, HOWEVER! I will open the church c. 8.30am weekdays (8.45am Sundays) after celebrating Mass, and Adoration will follow for quiet prayer until 10am. The church will remain open until 7pm, with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament again in the final hour before closing. Please do come and use the open church for prayer — this is a Government-acknowledged reason for being away from your home in these days. I am grateful to all the parish volunteers who continue to supervise the church's opening safely throughout each day.

PRAYER & LITURGY

NOVEMBER LIST OF THE DECEASED: Please return the lists to the presbytery, along with any Mass offering. During November, the lists will be kept on the altar and at least one Mass a day will be offered for the Holy Souls.

CHURCH OPENING: the church is open daily (c. 8.30am–7pm). Low-level supervision operates throughout each day, to ensure that all is safe: volunteer parishioners or Fr Philip or Fr Joshy, are available in church/porch. There are hygienic facilities in place, masks are to be worn, and distancing (2m from any person other than from one's own household) is to be maintained.

PUBLIC SUSPENSION OF MASS: Mass is celebrated by Fr Joshy & Fr Philip in private.

- The suspension of public Mass means that the *obligation to attend Sunday Mass is removed* for the duration of the suspension.
- Parish Masses, for the intentions requested, will be offered without fail, even though in private. Please continue to ask for Masses to be offered, and these will be published in the Newsletter as usual.
- Sunday Mass can be followed online from various churches. This is not an obligation, but would be a pious practice in order to stay in touch with the rhythm of the Church's seasons and her devotional life.
