My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,



Lord continues to provide us with the sacramental grace of His Holy Spirit for the stages of life, and for its challenges.



2020/21 Year of the Word: Pope Benedict XVI, Verbum Domini, n. 86

The *privileged place* for the prayerful reading of sacred Scripture *is the liturgy*, and particularly *the Eucharist*, in which, as we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ in the sacrament, the word itself is present and at work in our midst. In some sense the prayerful reading of the Bible, personal and communal, must always be related to the Eucharistic celebration. Just as the adoration of the Eucharist prepares for, accompanies and follows the liturgy of the Eucharist, so too prayerful reading, personal and communal, prepares for, accompanies and deepens what the Church celebrates when she proclaims the word in a liturgical setting. By so closely relating *lectio* and liturgy, we can better grasp the criteria which should guide this practice in the spiritual life of the People of God.

Holy Communion will be distributed carefully and slowly. You can give your usual weekly donation as you exit the church, rather than in the middle of Mass.
- Please note that the toilets will remain CLOSED.
- Confessions available again in the usual confessional, but only kneeling at the grille/curtain, not face to face.

5PM SUNDAY MASS: Please note that the 5pm Mass will probably cease after the 18th July.

CATECHETICS

RCIA: it would be good to hear from any adult who wishes to think about being Baptized, becoming a Catholic, or being Confirmed if they 'missed out' at a younger age. Do get in touch with Fr Philip, sooner rather than later, so that he can begin to form a group that in the autumn would gather and receive instruction and formation in the Catholic faith with a view to receiving the Sacrament(s) at Easter.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: 2020 First-Communion families whose children are not at St Cross or St Augustine's Primary schools: please endeavour to bring your child to have Confession again with Fr Philip at some point prior to their First-Holy Communion day. (Those at the Catholic schools have had this opportunity during school.)

FIRST-COMMUNIUON MASSES: these are *small* celebrations, to which *only the immediate household* of the First-Communion children can attend. This is to keep the numbers in church under the safe capacity of the church given the ongoing restrictions. Please *do not* try to attend these Masses unless you are of the First-Communicants' immediate household.
