My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,


THIS WEEKEND WE WELCOME BISHOP PAUL MCALEENAN. He is our auxiliary bishop in Herts, and he will celebrate the Saturday evening and Sunday Masses. Our spiritual father, Bishop Paul — who represents for us in Herts the Archbishop, Cardinal Vincent — has not been able to visit many of his parishes for a long while. So I am very happy to be able to welcome him here again to celebrate the holy Mass with us before I leave St Augustine's.

ALTHOUGH IT IS 'YEAR B' (THE YEAR OF ST MARK), yet in the summer of this year we always have a few Sundays hearing from

the great chapter in St John's Gospel, chapter 6, the chapter on the 'Bread of Life.' That begins this weekend with the events surrounding the miraculous 'multiplication of loaves' on the hillside above Lake Galilee. Our Lord's miracle is immediately recognised as a Messianic action, on a par with God's having fed the people of Israel with manna in the wilderness after the Exodus — this is why those who witnessed this feeding wish to "take Him by force and make Him King." What will follow over subsequent Sundays is the 'unpacking' of this sign of bread: Jesus will reveal more about His intentions to feed His people, not with bread but with the Holy Eucharist.

MY LEAVING MASS AND FAREWELL PARTY will be on Bank Holiday Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> August at 12 noon. Because this will be a very special celebration, I have chosen to make it a *professionally catered event*, so I need to know numbers of those able to attend. I would ask you, therefore, to **use the cut-out coupon** inside the Newsletter (*print it out* if you're reading this online!) and return it to the Presbytery a.s.a.p., and certainly in good time before the deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> August, please.

# 2020/21 Year of the Word: Pope Benedict XVI, Verbum Domini, n. 87

Lectio divina ... Following this comes prayer (*oratio*), which asks the question: what do we say to the Lord in response to his word? Prayer, as petition, intercession, thanksgiving and praise, is the primary way by which the word transforms us. Finally, lectio divina concludes with contemplation (*contemplatio*), during which we take up, as a gift from God, his own way of seeing and judging reality, and ask ourselves what conversion of mind, heart and life is the Lord asking of us? ... Contemplation aims at creating within us a truly wise and discerning vision of reality, as God sees it, ... We do well also to remember that the process of lectio divina is not concluded until it arrives at action (actio), which moves the believer to make his or her life a gift for others in charity.

- Please note that the toilets will remain CLOSED.
- Confessions available again in the usual confessional, but only *kneeling at the grille/curtain*, not face to face.

**5PM SUNDAY MASS:** Please note that this Mass ceased on the 18th July.

**YEAR OF ST JOSEPH** declared by Pope Francis (8th Dec 2020–21) — <u>prayer cards</u> are available.
