My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,




THE FIRST-HOLY-COMMUNION CELEBRATIONS are finally going ahead for our parish children who began preparing in autumn 2019. We pray for them and their families as they continue their Christian initiation and enter more fully into the sacramental life in Christ. This year these will be *small* celebrations, spread over the next 3 weekends, to which *only the immediate household* of the First-Communion children can attend. (This is to keep the numbers in church under the safe capacity of the church given the ongoing restrictions. Please do not try to attend these Masses unless you are of the First-Communicants' immediate household.)



PLEASE NOTE THESE IMPORTANT "DATES FOR YOUR DIARIES":

- (1) Weekend of 24th–25th July: we will have a parish visitation by Bishop Paul McAleenan, our auxiliary bishop in Herts, who will celebrate the Saturday evening and Sunday Masses. (I envisage that the Sunday 5pm Mass will not take place that weekend, or thereafter.) Do please come in good numbers that weekend to hear and greet Bishop Paul who has not been able to visit his parishes for a long while.
- **(2) Bank Holiday Monday** at the end of the summer (**Monday 30**th **August**): this is the date when I will celebrate a 'leaving Mass' which will be at midday. Afterwards there will be social gathering in the parish garden, to which all are invited, and for 'final farewells.' I shall be departing the following day for my new assignment in London, and Fr Julian will be moving in.

MASS INTENTIONS: there are many spare weekday & some weekend dates for intentions for you to request Mass in the coming weeks. Mass can be offered not only for the deceased, but also for the intentions of the sick, for special intentions, for thanksgiving etc. Intention can be published as 'Private Intention' if you so wish.

CHURCH OPENING: c. 8.15am–7pm, with **Adoration** at the beginning and at the end of the day (Mon–Fri). There are hygienic facilities in place, masks are to be worn, and distancing (2m from any person other than from one's own household) is to be maintained.

CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASS:

- Sunday Mass is shortened, to give time for sanitizing the church between Masses. There is no congregational singing, no Offertory Procession and no Sign of Peace. Holy Communion will be distributed carefully and slowly. You can give your usual weekly donation as you exit the church, rather than in the middle of Mass.
- *Please note that the toilets will remain CLOSED.*
- Confessions available again in the usual confessional, but only *kneeling at the grille/curtain*, not face to face.

5PM SUNDAY MASS: Please note that the 5pm Mass will probably cease after the 18th July.

YEAR OF ST JOSEPH declared by Pope Francis (8th Dec 2020–21) — <u>prayer cards</u> are available.

BISHOP PAUL MCALEENAN will be visiting our parish on the weekend of the 24th/25th July and will be celebrating all the Masses.

CATECHETICS

RCIA: it would be good to hear from any adult who wishes to think about being Baptized, becoming a Catholic, or being Confirmed if they 'missed out' at a younger age. Do get in touch with Fr Philip, sooner rather than later, so that he can begin to form a group that in the autumn would gather and receive instruction and formation in the Catholic faith with a view to receiving the Sacrament(s) at Easter.

BAPTISMS are permitted with up to 30 attendees. If you have completed a Baptism course with Fr Philip *previously*, then be in touch with the Presbytery to arrange a Sunday date for your child's baptism.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: 2020 First-Communion families whose children are not at St Cross or St Augustine's Primary schools: please endeavour to bring your child to have Confession again with Fr Philip at some point prior to their First-Holy Communion day.
