

Year B **EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR**

Gospel: John 6: 24-35 — He who comes to me will never be hungry; he who believes in me will never thirst.

My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,

FOR SEVERAL WEEKS, BEGINNING LAST SUNDAY, we have Sunday Gospel passages from Jn 6, the discourse of Jesus on "the Bread of Life." It is a very uplifting chapter, in which Our Lord gradually introduces to His disciples the miracle that He will be offering them, in due course, at the Last Supper: not just Himself in some metaphorical way as 'the Bread of Life,' but truly by way of a spiritual food that they can consume, His very Presence.

I do encourage you, now that restrictions are easing further, gradually, to return not only to Sunday Mass, but also to weekday Mass, which has sadly

seemed very empty for some weeks now. I also ask you again to be requesting for Mass to be offered for your various intentions through the week. Some weeks - such as the one ahead - I have to allocate several Mass intentions myself, that would otherwise have been blank! It is far more appropriate that you yourselves are asking for Mass to be offered here in our church at the daily Mass.

I AM TAKING A COUPLE OF WEEKS' HOLIDAY IN THIS FIRST HALF OF AUGUST, and I am extremely grateful to Fr Joshy for covering me for this fortnight across all the weekday and Sunday Masses. I ask you to assist in whatever ways possible, please, to help make it easier for him, especially at the weekends.

MY LEAVING MASS AND FAREWELL PARTY will be on Bank Holiday Monday, 30th August at 12 noon. Because this will be a very special celebration, I have chosen to make it a professionally catered event, so I need to know numbers of those able to attend. I would ask you, therefore, to **use the cut-out coupon** inside the Newsletter (*print it out* if you're reading this online!) and return it to the Presbytery a.s.a.p., and certainly in good time before the deadline of 15th August, please.


May the Lord truly bless us every time we come to be fed by Our Lord with Himself! Fr Philip



2020/21 Year of the Word: Pope Benedict XVI, Verbum Domini, n. 88

Mindful of the inseparable bond between the word of God and Mary of Nazareth, along with the Synod Fathers I urge that Marian prayer be encouraged among the faithful, above all in life of families, since it is an aid to meditating on the holy mysteries found in the Scriptures. A most helpful aid, for example, is the individual or communal recitation of the Holy Rosary, which ponders the mysteries of Christ's life in union with Mary, and which Pope John Paul II wished to enrich with the mysteries of light. It is fitting that the announcement of each mystery be accompanied by a brief biblical text pertinent to that mystery, so as to encourage the memorization of brief biblical passages relevant to the mysteries of Christ's life.

EVENING ADORATION: There will be **no Adoration** on **Friday 6**th **August**.

SUNDAY HOLY HOUR (Adoration, Evening Prayer & Benediction) will take place at **5pm on Sunday 29th August.**

URGENT! MASS INTENTIONS: there are very many spare *weekday & some weekend dates* for intentions for you to request Mass in the coming weeks. Mass can be offered not only for the deceased, but also for the intentions of the sick, for special intentions, for thanksgiving etc. Intention can be published as 'Private Intention' if you so wish.

CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASS:

- There *can* now be congregational singing, but we will continue with no Offertory Procession and no Sign of Peace for now. Holy Communion will be distributed carefully and slowly. You can give your usual weekly donation as you *exit* the church, rather than in the middle of Mass.
- Please note that the toilets will remain CLOSED.
- *Confessions* available again in the usual confessional, but only *kneeling at the grille/curtain*, not face to face.
