



My Dear Parishioners of St Augustine's,


AFTER PROBABLY ALMOST 700 PARISH NEWSLETTERS, I come to my last one. What a happy coincidence that my final weekend in the parish is also our patronal feast-day of St Augustine of Hippo! St Augustine is an inspirational saint, who, having struggled with faith in his early decades, gradually converted to Christ — with the aid of his mother's utter commitment to him, her prayers and tears, and the powerful witness and preaching of St Ambrose of Milan. He became a devoted writer, preacher, bishop and leader of Catholics in North Africa in the early 5th c., and one of the most famous saints of all time. He knew both personal and political

2020/21 Year of the Word: Pope Benedict XVI, Verbum Domini, n. 91

The word of God has bestowed upon us the divine life which transfigures the face of the earth, making all things new. His word engages us not only as *hearers* of divine revelation, but also as its *heralds*. The one whom the Father has sent to do his will draws us to himself and makes us part of his life and mission. The Spirit of the Risen Lord empowers us to proclaim the word everywhere by the witness of our lives. This was experienced by the first Christian community, which saw the word spread through preaching and witness. ... What the Church proclaims to the world is the *Logos of Hope*; in order to be able to live fully each moment, men and women need "the great hope" which is "the God who possesses a human face and who 'has loved us to the end.' This is

why the Church is missionary by her very nature. We cannot keep to ourselves the words of eternal life given to us in our encounter with Jesus Christ: they are meant for everyone, for every man and woman. Everyone today, whether he or she knows it or not, needs this message.



PRAYER & LITURGY

WE WELCOME INTO THE CHURCH Sienna Ednie and Siena Amico who will be baptised this weekend.

SUNDAY HOLY HOUR (Adoration, Evening Prayer & Benediction) will take place at **5pm on Sunday 29th August.**

FR PHILIP'S LEAVING MASS will be held on Bank Holiday **Monday 30**th **Aug at 12 noon**.

ADORATION: There will be no 6pm Adoration on **Monday evening.**

URGENT! MASS INTENTIONS: there are very many spare *weekday* & *some weekend dates* for intentions for you to request Mass in the coming weeks. Mass can be offered not only for the deceased, but also for the intentions of the sick, for special intentions, for thanksgiving etc. Intention can be published as 'Private Intention' if you so wish.

CELEBRATION OF PUBLIC MASS:

- There *can* now be congregational singing, but we will continue with no Offertory Procession and no Sign of Peace for now. Holy Communion will be distributed carefully and slowly. You can give your usual weekly donation as you *exit* the church, rather than in the middle of Mass.
- Please note that the toilets will remain CLOSED.
- *Confessions* available again in the usual confessional, but only *kneeling at the grille/curtain*, not face to face.


