Gospel: Luke 21: 25-28, 34-36 *Your liberation is near at hand.*

Are we losing our grip? We should be, for today is Advent Sunday, the start of the season which reminds us that everything other than God is provisional and that time temporal is running out. Our readings proclaim that the Lord is coming back. The clock is five minutes to midnight. Are we on the right track for heaven, and prepared for his return? As if to reinforce the message our bishops have asked us whether we are truly honouring the Lord in our Mass attendance, or is our acquaintance a casual visit. How important for us is attending



Mass, relative to attending to our other Sunday activities? As the Sunday Mass is the very heartbeat of the Church and of our personal life of faith, they remind us that, 'Our Lord Jesus invites us to receive anew the gift of Sunday as the preeminent day, the day of the Resurrection, when the Church gathers to celebrate the Eucharist. Here we stand together before our heavenly Father, offering our thanksgiving and prayer, through our Saviour in the Holy Spirit. Here we receive Christ in his Word. Here we are nourished by Christ in his precious Body and Blood. This is our primary joy, for which there is no substitute, and from which we draw our strength. We gather on the "first day of the week," and devote ourselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers (Acts 2:42). The Eucharist sustains us and spurs us on, renewing our gratitude and our hope. When we say "Amen" to Christ in receiving his Body and Blood, we express the love of God which is deep within us, and at the end of Mass, when we are sent forth, we express our love for our neighbour, especially those in need. These two dimensions reveal the full meaning of our faith. We are gathered together and sent out, we pray and are fed, we worship and we adore; these are intrinsic to our lives as those baptised into Christ.

While recognising that for some it may still be impossible to fulfil the Sunday obligation of Mass attendance, the bishops remind us that Mass attendance remains obligatory. It is our personal response to the selfless offering of Christ's love, who said 'Do this in remembrance of me'. There are many things that Jesus also told us to do, but if we had to stand before him tonight, should he return or should we leave this mortal life, would we be able to say to him in confidence I gave you the priority of my time and my life in keeping the faith?? As we enter Advent, conscious that we do not know not the time or the hour of his return, let's take stock of where we are. Let's put right what's amiss and keep awake.
