

Gospel: Luke 1: 1-4, 4: 14-21 *This text is being fulfilled today.* 

This week sees the start of the annual octave of Prayer for Christian Unity when we are reminded that praying for unity across the Church is not an option. Why? Because it is what Jesus desires. In the last supper he prayed to his Father that his followers 'should be one as we are one'. This is unity not just within our own ranks but also with those Christian brothers and sisters, who for whatever reason felt that they needed to worship separately. What we know is that there is only one Church, the Church which Christians affirm in the Creeds as the one holy catholic apostolic Church. Thinking of a family may help. Some family members are estranged from others, but they all bear an unmistakeable likeness and some genetic makeup to the ancestral parent. Ultimately, their differences can never outweigh their similarities. This Sunday evening at 6pm we are hosting the Unity Service at St Augustine's. Our hope is that many Christians from across Hoddesdon,



Broxbourne and Wormley will be present. How gracious it would be on our part if we were able to welcome them. To do that we need to be present. If you are free and able to come that would be a blessing. But we ourselves will be blessed as well, as we will hear how God has encouraged members of the community to step out in faith and to share the love of Christ often in very practical ways. The theme of the evening service will be Thanksgiving for what God has been doing through the Church. We give thanks not for what we do for God, but for what He does for us and for others.
