FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

8th MAY 2022

Gospel: John 10: 27-30 I give eternal life to the sheep that belong to me.

I was brought up on a hill farm in Mid-Wales where there are more sheep than people. As you can imagine, I saw at first hand differing shepherding styles and practices. When I was very young my Father gave me some orphaned lambs to rear. I named them after Anglo-Saxon kings and queens, although one earned the name of Tiglath-Pileser, an Assyrian ruler in the Old Testament, as he was always butting the other lambs. I would spend quite a lot of time with them, observing their routines of feeding and behaviour. I copied what my teachers did, by keeping a register and noting their daily progress. After I had won their trust, I found that they naturally responded to my voice, even when they were several fields away. It is true that



once you build up a relationship with our ovine friends, as with other animals, they will respond to your voice and follow you. Jesus said that 'the sheep that belong to me listen to my voice; I know them and they follow me'. In the case of my orphaned lambs, one reason why they responded to my voice was because they knew that I would give them a good meal. It is the same for us in the Christian flock. We listen to Jesus' voice because we know that when he speaks, we are fed by his Word. Even more so when we are fed by his very Body. This act of feeding, on the basis of Jesus' command to Peter, 'feed my sheep' is the very mark of what being a shepherd is, as well as the measure that Jesus sets for the shepherd's love of Himself. Today is Good Shepherd Sunday when we pray for more candidates to explore the possibility of becoming shepherds of the flock. No one takes this upon themselves. It is a vocation, that to which one is called. But please remember....only sheep may apply! Before any one becomes a shepherd, one first has to be a sheep, and doing what sheep are meant to do, listening to the Shepherd's voice, and responding to Him always remain at the heart of the pastoral ministry. The Lord is my Shepherd?
