PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK AT THE PARISH CENTRE KITCHEN

1) Replacement of entire kitchen including worktops, wall and base units. 2) Existing dishwasher, fridge and oven cooker will be disconnected, set aside and refitted. 3) Kitchen layout will be the same as existing for pricing purpose. 4) Replace access hatch and door to the hall to be 30minute fire resistant. 5) Remove existing floor covering and skirtings and allow to repair and latex as necessary. 6) Install new vinyl flooring with coved skirting to perimeter. 7) Carry out test to all existing wiring and electrical installation. 8) Repair damaged sockets, extractor fan. 9) Full redecoration to entire kitchen. 10) All plumbing, drainage and associated building works are included above. 11) Provisional - Electrics remedial works. 12) Provisional - Retrofit or replace existing roller shutters to connect to fire alarm system. 13) Provisional - Replace existing wall tiles with new including UPVC edge trims. Allow full height to ceiling to the wall behind the oven cooker.

CORRIDOR LOBBIES

- 1) Localized repairs to floor covering to make safe. 2) Full prepare and redecorate all walls.
- 3) Full prepare and redecorate ceilings (understood the leaks had been fixed previously).
- 4) Repair and refurbish all fire doors along and between kitchen and corridor lobbies.

MALE WC

1) Full prepare and redecorate all walls with anti-condensation paint. 2) Full prepare and redecorate ceiling with anti-condensation paint.

FEMALE WC

1) Full prepare and redecorate all walls with anti-condensation paint. 2) Full prepare and redecorate ceiling with anti-condensation paint (understood the leaks had been fixed previously).

ACCESSIBLE WC

1) Retile the boxing LHS to WC pan to match existing (white tiles had been used). 2) Provisional – rebuild boxing above including new tiles to match existing.

OTHERS

1) Repair floor underlay and install recessed matwell with frame to the nursery hall exit.

SIGNING THE CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

The Archdiocese requires that families attend regularly (that is weekly) for at least **TWO years** before a Priest is able to sign your form.

If you are new to the Parish, you will need a letter from your previous Parish Priest in order to obtain a signed Certificate of Catholic Practice from the Parish Clergy. Parents, YOU are responsible for the FULL education of your children. Parents looking for Admission, please visit the Local Council & Schools or their websites. Once your school application is ready, then sign the Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP) with the Priest and submit your applications to Council & Schools.

The Certificates of Catholic Practice are signed:

(A). For Secondary Transfer - Year 7 (in Sept -Oct), Reception (in Dec - Jan) & Nursery (in Mar- Apr), please keep reading the Newsletter and visit the Parish Website for more information.

(B). For School years (Yr1 to Yr6) or other School years (Yr8 onwards). Please make an appointment directly through email with any of the Priests for the signing of CCP.
