## SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

12<sup>th</sup> June 2022

### REFLECTION ON THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

We celebrate today the great mystery of the Most Holy Trinity - God is One in Three Persons. This article of our Creed is taken from the Bible as evident from the biblical texts read at Mass today. The Wisdom of God, as shown in Proverbs 8, 22-31, is God's possession before all things began. This same Wisdom of God was manifest at the creation. When devil used our first parents to corrupt God's creation, it took the incarnation of the same Wisdom of God, Jesus Christ to rescue the situation. Writing to the Romans 5, 1-5, Paul observes that our justification by faith in Christ earned us eternal peace with God due to the love of God poured in us through the Holy Spirit. Repeating the words of Jesus to his disciples, John sums it up thus: "The Holy Spirit will take from what is mine which is also the Father's, and declare it to you" (John 16, 12-15). So, we truly believe in God who is Three Persons. Each Person is distinct but never acts independently. The term Trinity might not have been used in the Bible, but the teaching is present in seed form in the Old Testament and explicit in the New Testament. Our finite human mind is incapable of comprehending this mystery of God. We accept the truth of God's word in the Bible by faith. Theologians have pointed out that if it were untrue, the Bible would be unreliable; Christ would not be divine, and His death on the cross would not atone for our sins, being merely the death of a martyr. May God strengthen our faith in this mystery and improve our love of Him in His Son through the Holy Spirit, Amen.

### **NEW PARISHIONERS**

We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. We want you to feel at home in the parish. The first thing to do is to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM** which is available in the parish office and also in the porch area of the church. Thereafter, you are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the **MAILBOX in the Presbytery door**. Your completed form will be processed later by the Parish Office. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed, as we deal with large volumes of forms every week. To obtain your family ID number, please send an email to the parish office **[hounslow@rcdow.org.uk](mailto:hounslow@rcdow.org.uk)**, providing your full name and date of birth. Old members who have not registered in the parish are requested to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM** without further delay. The second thing to do if you are new in the parish is to read the weekly parish newsletter. **Please note we DO NOT have ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM**. If you are a visitor or worshipping with us for the first time, you are very welcome to our parish family.

### **SIGNING THE CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP) FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS**

The Archdiocese requires that families attend regularly (that is weekly) for at least **TWO years** before a Priest is able to sign your form. **If you are new to the Parish**, you will need **a letter** from your

previous Parish Priest in order to obtain a signed Certificate of Catholic Practice from the Parish Clergy. Parents, YOU are responsible for the FULL education of your children. **Parents looking for Admission**, please visit the **Local Council & Schools or their websites**. Once your school application is ready, then sign the Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP) with the Priest and submit your applications to Council & Schools. **The Certificates of Catholic Practice are signed:**

**(A). For Secondary Transfer - Year 7 (in Sept -Oct), Reception (in Dec - Jan) & Nursery (in Mar- Apr),** please keep reading the Newsletter and visit the Parish Website for more information.

**(B). For School years (Yr1 to Yr6) or other School years (Yr8 onwards).**

**Please make an appointment directly through email with any of the Priests for the signing of CCP.**

### **MORE VOLUNTEERS CATECHISTS ARE NEEDED**

We request for more Volunteer Catechists for our next sacramental programmes (Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation and RCIA). Beginning from the 2022/2023 sacramental programmes in September 2022, we will resume face to face catechetical classes. To safeguard our children properly, more Volunteer Catechists are needed so that the programmes can be organised successfully. If you are interested in becoming a Volunteer Catechist, please forward your name and contact details to the Parish Catechist, Lionel Pereira. He will organise the initial training for Volunteer Catechists. Thereafter, the Volunteer Catechists will still be offered opportunities for further training as the need arises. It is important for parents to note that if we do not get the required number of Volunteer Catechists to organise our different catechetical programmes successfully in accordance with the relevant Safeguarding policy, we will therefore reduce the number of children who will be admitted to our First Holy Communion and Confirmation Programmes.
