Members who have not registered in the parish are requested to complete the PARISH REGISTRATION FORM without further delay. Please note we DO NOT have ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM. If you are a visitor or worshipping with us for the first time, you are very welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. SIGNING OF CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP)

Please contact either Fr Damian-Mary or Fr David for the signing of CCP for your children. It is a formal requirement to present your child's previous and current Mass Attendance Cards before a priest will sign the CCP as requested. Kindly note that Fr Austin Nwosu, CSSp. is no longer available for the signing of CCP.

RETURN TO MASS

Recently, the bishops of England and Wales issued a statement about the obligation of Sunday Mass for those who wish to be practising Catholics. The text 'Returning to Mass at Pentecost' is linked on the homepage of the parish website. In essence they say: "We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply". The statement is called an "Invitation" for all to be putting Sunday and Holy Day worship in first place as of Pentecost Sunday. The Church has long held that those unable to exercise their Sunday obligation due to poor health are exempt.
