SIGNING OF CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE (CCP)

Please contact either Fr Daniel, Fr Damian-Mary or Fr David for the signing of CCP for your

children. It is a formal requirement to present your child's previous and current Mass Attendance Cards before a priest will sign the CCP as requested. **If you are new to the Parish**, you will need **a letter** from your previous Parish Priest in order to obtain a signed Certificate of Catholic Practice from the Parish Clergy.

PARISH CENTRE RENOVATION UPDATES

A quote of £41,376.00, inclusive of VAT, meant for the renovation work in the Parish Centre has been approved by the Parish and the Diocese. HOW TO REGISTER IN THIS PARISH?

The first thing to do is to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM (GREEN FORM)** which is available in the parish office and also in the porch area of the church. Thereafter, you are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the **MAILBOX in the Presbytery door**. Your completed form will be processed later by the Parish Office. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed, as we deal with large volumes of forms every week. To obtain your family ID number, please send an email to the parish office **hounslow@rcdow.org.uk**, providing your full name and date of birth. Members who have not registered in the parish are requested to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM** without further delay.

Please note we DO NOT have ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM. If you are a visitor or worshipping with us for the first time, you are very welcome to our parish family.

SUPPORT FOR RETIRED PRIESTS


CONFIRMATION ATTENDANCE CARDS AND STICKERS
