NOVEMBER – MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

Tuesday 1st November - All Saints' Day - Masses at 9am and 6pm.

All Saints Day is a holy day of Obligation. Catholic are required to attend the Holy Mass, to avoid (to the extent that they are able) servile work and spend time in prayer. It has the same spiritual and liturgical status as a Sunday.

Wednesday 2nd November All Souls' Day - Masses at 7.30am, 9am, 12noon, 6pm & 7:30pm.

On <u>Friday 18th November at 7pm</u> we will have our <u>Annual Bereavement Mass</u> (choir led by the S.C.S Team), for all families in the Parish who have lost their loved ones since November 2021. It will begin with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 5:30pm and Benediction at 6:30pm. Thereafter, please join us for refreshments in the Parish Centre.

<u>Plenary indulgence</u> - A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (I) on one of the days 1-8 November visit devoutly a cemetery or simply pray mentally for the dead; (2) on All Souls' Day visit a church or chapel with devotion and there recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (I) visit devoutly Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation 'Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord'.........

Book of Remembrance: Throughout November there will be a book in the Church for parishioners to *write the names of their deceased relatives/friends*.
