ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday begins the 40-day Lenten season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Ash Wednesday to Holy Saturday — lasts 44 days, but the number of days for penance and fasting before Easter is still 40. Sundays are not days of fasting and abstinence. By the Lenten 40 days, the Church unites itself to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59, and abstinence binds from 14 onwards. Fasting means a person is permitted to eat one full meal — (two smaller meals may also be taken, both not equal to a full meal). After Ash Wednesday, we should participate in daily Mass, do self-imposed observance of fasting, and involve ourselves in charity to local, national, and world programs through Lent. Lent is an intense period appropriate for spiritual exercises, penitential liturgies, pilgrimages as signs of penance, voluntary self-denial such as fasting and almsgiving, and fraternal sharing.

Usually, the ashes come from the palm branches of the previous Palm Sunday. They are equivalent to dust and human flesh and symbolize death and repentance. Anyone can receive it. By the Rites of Ashes, we indicate sorrow for our sins and our desire for repentance. We strive to correct our faults, purify our hearts, control our desires and grow in holiness in readiness for Easter. (From Multiple Sources)

MASS ATTENDANCE CARDS AND STICKERS

Parents are reminded to take note of this development, and to remember that they are responsible for bringing their children to the church for weekend Masses, and on time as well. The new Mass Attendance Card (Yellow Colour) (Sept 2022- Jun 2023) is for children in Year 5 and below only. This Card will be requested by the Priest before signing of the *Certificate of Catholic Practise (CCP) for Catholic Schools*. Stickers will be given when you ENTER THE CHURCH BEFORE MASS BEGINS.

- Please ensure your card has a recent <u>PHOTO</u> of your child and their <u>FULL NAME</u>.
- All parents are reminded that a sticker will only be issued if the child is present for the Mass.
- Stickers will not be given if the card is not presented. We will stop issuing stickers once the First Reading starts.

For CCP, come to the Parish Office, between 10 am-12noon, on **Tuesdays or Thursdays.** Please ensure you have your Mass attendance card from the *previous year*. If you are new to the parish, bring <u>a letter from your previous parish confirming your attendance</u>. No appointments required!

If you are a visitor or worship with us for the first time, you are welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE — whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS — so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their marriage paperwork in the parish **should contact** either Fr Daniel Adayi, CSSp, or Fr Damian-Mary Moneke, CSSp, via email.
