THE CLEANSING OF OUR TEMPLE IN THIS SEASON OF LENT

The Gospel of today tells about when Jesus did Cleaning to the Temple. The Passover was the greatest of Jewish feasts, like our Christmas. And it drew all kinds of pilgrims from all over the world to this capital city Jerusalem. They came to celebrate their deliverance from Egypt to the Promised Land. People travelled long distances, so they didn't bring animals for sacrifice with them. They bought them on the spot. People needed to exchange their various coins for the standard Temple currency, like in Lourdes, before they could buy things. At the Passover, the Temple became a shopping centre and mall. Animal business, money exchanged, buying and selling. When Jesus saw this, he became indignant. With a whip, he beat and drove them all and turned over all their tables in the Temple. What does it all mean? For John and the disciples, it remembered that it was fulfilling the prophecy that the Messiah would purify the Temple. The Temple needed radical cleaning, and, occasionally, so do our lives. That is the reason for Lent! Our lives need cleaning just like our homes and offices do. Over time, excess baggage, useless junk and dust balls tend to accumulate. Merchants and money changers must be driven out of the Temple of our lives. Therefore, Lent is a time to cleanse our Temple to remove, to expel severely and radically all our life's infidelities, sins and distortions. Every life needs regular spring cleansing, or else we can end up like some people who don't notice the sin and clutter around them anymore.

MASS ATTENDANCE CARDS AND STICKERS

Parents are reminded to take note of this development, and to remember that they are responsible for bringing their children to the church for weekend Masses, and on time as well. The new Mass Attendance Card (Yellow Colour) (Sept 2022- Jun 2023) is for children in Year 5 and below only. This Card will be requested by the Priest before signing of the *Certificate of Catholic Practise (CCP) for Catholic Schools*. Stickers will be given when you ENTER THE CHURCH BEFORE MASS BEGINS.

- All parents are reminded that a sticker will only be issued if the child is present for the Mass.
- Stickers will not be given if the card is not presented. We will stop issuing stickers once the First Reading starts.

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE — whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS — so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their marriage paperwork in the parish **should contact** either Fr Daniel Adayi, CSSp, or Fr Damian-Mary Moneke, CSSp, via email. Thank you for your understanding and anticipated cooperation.
