FEAST OF THE DIVINE MERCY 10 DEVOTION TO DIVINE MERCY FROM SR FAUSTINA'S DIARY

Our Lord commanded that an image be painted according to the pattern that he showed Sr. Faustina and that the image be venerated throughout the world. He also requested that the Chaplet be said: "Encourage souls to say the Chaplet that I have given you." In addition, he desired that the Feast of Mercy be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter as a guarantee of peace for humanity. Here are some quotes from St Faustina's Diary:

Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God. All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy (No. 301).

My daughter, have fear of nothing; I am always with you. All your adversaries will harm you only to the degree that I permit them to do so. You are my dwelling place and my constant repose. For your sake I will withhold the hand which punishes; for your sake, I bless the earth (No. 431).

Jesus: 'My child, life on earth is a struggle indeed, a great struggle for my kingdom. But fear not, because you are not alone. I always support you, so lean on Me as you struggle, fearing nothing. Take the vessel of trust and draw from the fountain of life – for yourself and other souls, especially those who are distrustful of My goodness (No. 1488).

All grace flows from mercy, and the last hour abounds with mercy for us. Let no one doubt concerning the goodness of God; even if a person's sins were as dark as night, God's mercy is stronger than our misery. One thing alone is necessary; that the sinner set ajar the door of his heart, be it ever so little, to let in a ray of God's merciful grace, and then God will do the rest (No. 1507).

HOW TO REGISTER IN THIS PARISH?

The first thing to do is to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM (GREEN FORM)** available in the parish office and the porch area of the church. Thereafter, you are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the **MAILBOX in the Presbytery door**. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed.

To obtain your family ID number, please email the parish office at **hounslow@rcdow.org.uk**, providing your full name and date of birth. If you are a visitor or worship with us for the first time, you are welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. We want you to feel at home in the parish.

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give **6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE** – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their

marriage paperwork in the parish **should contact** either Fr Daniel Adayi, CSSp, or Fr Damian-Mary Moneke, CSSp, via email. Thank you for your understanding and anticipated cooperation.
