## SOLEMNITY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

04<sup>th</sup> June 2023

### SPIRITAN PRESENCE IN THE UNITED KINGDOM

The Holy Ghost Fathers (Spiritans) currently work in about sixty-six countries, collaborating with the local churches in various capacities. In the UK, the Spiritans actively engage in parish ministry, Chaplaincies (prisons, hospitals, schools and airports), youth ministry and the support of the migrant communities in ten dioceses. The Congregation also has a team of lay persons – Spiritan Lay Associates – who are committed to the Spiritan vision to be “the advocates, the supporters and the defenders of the weak and the little ones against all who oppress them” (Spiritans Rule of Life #14). Among outreach projects are Revive, Just Youth and Bickley Community.

### REVIVE

Revive is a community project providing free practical and emotional support to refugees and asylum seekers. It provides high-quality services, including friendly drop-in services offering advice, guidance, and support on immigration, housing, healthcare, and education; emergency provisions, specialized casework; advocacy; and volunteering opportunities. Revive manages the two service hubs in Beswick and Salford. REVIVE accepts self-referrals and referrals from other agencies. (<https://spiritans.co.uk/revive/>).

### BICKLEY COMMUNITY

The Bickley community dates back to 1947 and served different purposes, including welcoming veterans who wished to be missionary priests, including many of our elderly Spiritans. Since late 2015, the Bickley community has mainly become a residential community, offering residential retreat space and Bread & Breakfast Guest Accommodation (<https://spiritans.co.uk/bickley/>). **Continued on page 2.....**

Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed.

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush.

### WHERE TO FIND INFORMATION ON PARISH SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMMES

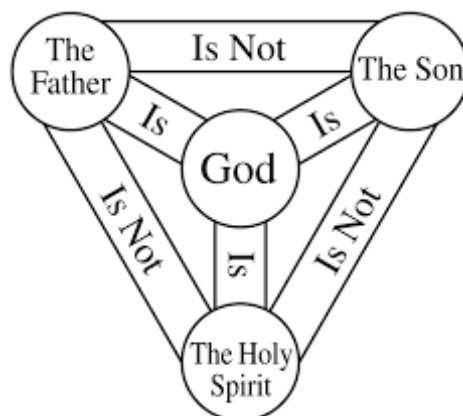
