THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BODY AND BLOOD OFCHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)11 June 2023

Receiving Holy Communion with Proper Reverence (1) Make a Sign of Reverence

As the communicant in front of you receives Holy Communion, you are to make a sign of reverence -a bow. You then approach the Priest or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (from now on, Priest) with your hands extended. The Priest then lifts the Sacred Host, shows it to the communicant, and says, "The Body of Christ". The communicant says, "Amen". If one receives on the tongue, the communicant approaches the Priest, who lifts the Host and shows it to the communicant and says, "The Body of Christ." The communicant then says "Amen," opens his/her mouth and extends his/her tongue (Please be sure to hold still until after the Host is placed on your tongue!). Please Do Not Move.

After bowing as a sign of reverence, whether you receive on the tongue or the hand -- DO NOT MOVE -- until the Priest has placed the Sacred Host on your tongue or hand and removed his hand.

If One Receives on the Hand

Unless arthritis hinders one, hold your top hand flat. And do not move until the Priest has placed the Sacred Host on your hand and removed his. Do not move your hand, arms, fingers, etc.

If Your Hand/Hands are Impeded

Never receive Holy Communion in the hand when your hands are impeded, e.g., carrying a cane or some other walking-assistance device, carrying a child in your arms, carrying a purse, having a tissue or handkerchief in your hand, having a cast on your hand, etc. Never receive Holy Communion by extending only one hand. Never reach and grab the Host! - **Continues next week.**

HOW TO REGISTER IN THIS PARISH?

The first thing to do is to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM (GREEN FORM)** available in the parish office and the porch area of the Church. You are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the **MAILBOX in the Presbytery door**. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed.

To obtain your family ID number, please email the parish office at **hounslow@rcdow.org.uk**, providing your full name and date of birth. If you are a visitor or worship with us for the first time, you are welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. We want you to feel at home in the Parish.

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

It would be best to give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH.
