RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION WITH REVERENCE (5)

How many times can a person receive Holy Communion in one day?

The Code of Canon Law (No. 917) stipulates, "A person who has received the Most Holy Eucharist may receive it again on the same day only during the celebration of the Eucharist in which the person participates." Following this lead, Canon 921, 2 stipulates, "Even if they have received Communion on the same day, those who are in danger of death are strongly urged to receive again." Catholics can receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist at the most, 2 times per day, if certain conditions are met. You may receive Holy Communion when you attend two separate celebrations of the Holy Mass on the same day [Canon Law # 917; CCC. # 1388] when:

1. You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a funeral during which there is a Eucharistic celebration.
2. You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a wedding during which there is a Eucharistic celebration.
3. You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and receive the Last Rites (Anointing of the Sick).
4. You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a Vigil Holy Mass on the same day.

A third Mass and receiving Communion a third time on the same day appears NOT to be in conformity to the spirit of the law nor to current practice and interpretation. If a Catholic has already received the Sacrament of Holy Communion during the day and he is facing the danger of death, during the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick (Last Rites), he can once more receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist on the same day.

Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed. If you are a visitor or worship with us for the first time, you are welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. We want you to feel at home in the parish.

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their
