JESUS IS THE TREASURE: THE SCRIPTURE IS THE FIELD

The parable of the treasure buried in the field and the parable of the pearl draw upon a common but powerful experience: the joy of discovering what was previously hidden. Man is a seeker who believes there is something really worth seeking. And while his curiosity can be caught up for a time in natural wonders and pleasures, he always longs for more. The answers to those essential questions can be given only by God. Some of the early Christian Fathers saw the parable of the treasure as a metaphor for the Incarnation and how the Truth about God is finally found hidden in a man—not any man, but the Son of God, Jesus Christ. "If anyone reads the Scriptures with attention," wrote Saint Irenaeus, "he will find in them an account of Christ and a foreshadowing of the new calling. For Christ is the treasure which was hidden in the field, that is, in this world but the treasure hid in the Scriptures is Christ, since He was pointed out by means of types and parables" (Against Heresies, 4.26.1). The treasures of Christ and Scripture are intimately linked to one another, for Christ fulfils Scripture even as Scripture proclaims Christ. The seeker of Truth can explore both. - From the July 27, 2008, edition of Our Sunday Visitor.

HOW TO REGISTER IN THIS PARISH?

The first thing to do is to complete the PARISH REGISTRATION FORM (GREEN FORM) available in the parish office and the porch area of the church. Thereafter, you are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the MAILBOX in the Presbytery door. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed. To obtain your family ID number, please email the parish office at hounslow@rcdow.org.uk, providing your full name and date of birth. If you are a visitor or worship with us for the first time, you are welcome to our parish family. We welcome all new parishioners to St Michael and St Martin Catholic Church Hounslow. We want you to feel at home in the parish.

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples

or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS — so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH.
