30th Sunday in Ordinary Time NOVEMBER – MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

<u>Wednesday 1st November - All Saints' Day</u> - Masses at 7:30am, 9am and 6pm. All Saints Day is a holy day of Obligation. Catholic are required to attend the Holy Mass, to avoid (to the extent that they are able) servile work and spend time in prayer. It has the same spiritual and liturgical status as a Sunday.

Thursday 2nd November All Souls' Day - Masses at 7.30am, 9am, 12noon, 6pm & 7:30pm.

<u>Plenary indulgence</u> - A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (I) on one of the days 1-8 November visit devoutly a cemetery or simply pray mentally for the dead; (2) on All Souls' Day visit a church or chapel with devotion and there recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (I) visit devoutly Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation 'Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord'.....

Book of Remembrance: Throughout November there will be a book in the Church for parishioners to *write the names of their deceased relatives/friends.*

MASS ATTENDANCE CARDS AND STICKERS

- All parents are reminded that a sticker will only be issued if the child is present for the Mass.

• Stickers will not be given if the card is not presented. We will stop issuing stickers once the First Reading starts.

HOW TO REGISTER IN THIS PARISH?

The first thing to do is to complete the **PARISH REGISTRATION FORM (GREEN FORM)** available in the parish office and the porch area of the church. Thereafter, you are requested to slip the completed parish registration form into the **MAILBOX in the Presbytery door**. Please allow at least two weeks for the Parish Registration forms to be processed. To obtain your family ID number, please email the parish office at **hounslow@rcdow.org.uk**, providing your full name and date of birth.

CATHOLIC CERTIFICATE OF PRACTICE (CCP) SIGNING

• **Tuesdays or Thursdays** (10am - 12noon). Please ensure you have your Mass attendance card from the previous year. If you are new to the parish, bring <u>a letter from your PREVIOUS parish confirming</u> <u>your attendance</u>. No appointments required!

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their marriage paperwork in the parish **should contact** Fr Damian-Mary Moneke, CSSp (contact details are available on page 1).
