The Church at Advent: Excited by an Anticipated Joy

The Advent season is a season of expectation. Expectation comes with joy - the joy of hope. This joy is borne out of faith in the word of God about the coming Messiah. Aside the primary meaning of the Emmanuel prophecy (Isaiah 7:14), its fuller sense alludes to the birth of Jesus – the expected Messiah. Jesus is indeed our Emmanuel, he is the living sign that God will never abandon us. In the same vein, the prophecy of a glorious future (Isaiah 9:1-7) which will become possible because "a child is borne to us" finds its ultimate interpretation in the incarnation.

At Advent the Church expresses her longing and yearning for the fulfilment of God's promise. Now, this promise has already been fulfilled at the incarnation. Hence, this period is a period of preparation, a two-fold preparation. On the one hand, it is a preparation for the second coming of Christ (parousia). On the other hand, it is the preparation to celebrate the anniversary of the first coming (Christmas). In other words, advent is a double-edged sword, while presenting a platform for Christians to remember the event of the incarnation and what it means for them, it also calls them to reflect on and prepare for the second coming of Christ.

The works of the Messiah carried out during the time of his earthly ministry still make meaning today and has remained the motivation for many works going on in the lives of Christians. Having been reconciled with God, we now relish the joy of our salvation. We are the people who once walked in darkness but have now seen a great light (Isaiah 9:2). The prophet Isaiah captures quite clearly what the Messiah will accomplish upon his arrival. These tasks of the Messiah could be recognized from the names with which he will be called: wonderful counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6). The Messiah is our teacher, he gives us the best counsel, he is mighty and so will free us from the grasp of Satan, he will be a father to us, showing us the path to eternal happiness, and he will give us peace of a more lasting kind.

The features of the year of the Lord, previously announced by Isaiah (61:1-3) were subsequently applied to Jesus by the evangelist Luke (4:16-20) since it is in Jesus that we witness the coming of God's kingdom. Hence, while we await his second coming, let us continue to enjoy the benefits of the first: good news to the poor, binding up the broken hearted, liberty to captives, freedom to those in prison, the Lord's favour to all, comfort to those who mourn. Furthermore, the Lord's favour is seen in the healing and restoration we enjoy: the lame walk, the deaf hear, the blind see, the dumb speak, those in any kind of captivity are freed. At Advent we remember, relive, recognize, and appreciate the joy of our salvation wrought for us at his first coming. Our sentiment of joy is captured well in the old hymn which proclaims the mystery of our faith: "keep in mind that Jesus Christ has died for us, and is risen from the dead, he is our saving Lord, he is joy for all ages."
