### PARISH ROOF REPAIR WORKS

The work will resume on Monday the 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> June and 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> July (except 4<sup>th</sup> July). The work on these dates will begin at 9:45am till 12:30pm and start again from 1:30pm till 5pm. On these dates and hours, please note that car park will be totally inaccessible for health and safety reasons. Parishioners are advised to follow these timings strictly and to remove their cars immediately after the morning Mass latest 9:40am and driving in for evening Mass, not earlier than 5:30pm. Cars must not be parked in the car park during these working hours.

### ALTAR SERVERS APPLICATION AND TRAINING

The training for Altar Servers will continue on the 27<sup>th</sup> of July and the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August, with all sessions starting promptly at 10:30 AM in the Church. Application forms will be distributed over three weeks, starting on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June and concluding on Sunday, the 7<sup>th</sup> of July, in the Church.

Children interested in becoming Altar Servers can collect these forms and the Parish volunteer policy, fill them out, and return them with parental consent for the live-streamed Mass. Please remember to place the completed application in an envelope, seal it carefully, and include the documents for Baptism and FHC certificates. **Applications should be submitted by placing them in the mailbox of the parish office addressed to Fr. Ignatius, with the deadline before 3:00 PM, on Monday, the 15<sup>th</sup> of July.** Without these documents and consent, the application will be considered invalid.

### ADMISSION IN A HOSPITAL

If you are admitted to any hospital (or a family member), and desires to receive Holy Communion or Sacrament of Anointing, kindly inform the staff there to call a Priest on duty for you. You have to notify them by telling them that you are a Roman Catholic. There is a Priest on duty every day in any hospital. For those going to West Middlesex Hospital, all the parishes in Hounslow Deanery take turns to respond to hospital calls on daily basis. **St Michael and St Martin Church Hounslow covers West Middlesex Hospital every Thursday from 6am to Friday 6am.** However, should any sick parishioners require a priest, please do not hesitate to contact us at any time.
