PARISH CHURCH REDOCARATION AND CHANGE OF PARISH CHURCH SOUND SYSTEM

Having done with our parish church roof repairs, and reroofing of the presbytery garage which cost £25,815.60.

Our Parish Church is in urgent state for redecoration and change of sound system in order to address the ugly sight that the water ingress in the church has caused and also change to more effective sound system for more efficient communication during our liturgical celebrations. The Diocesan Property Department and the Parish have been collaborating on developing a realistic plan for the redecoration of the Parish Church and change of the sound system. Some contractors have been invited to come and tender their quotes for the redecoration of the Parish Church and the change of the sound system. Having received their quotes, the Parish Finance Council approved the most realistic quotes. The Parish Finance Council has already approved the redecoration of the Parish Church and change of the sound system.

We have also followed the established Diocesan due process. We have approached the Diocese Chief Operating Officer for the required approval since the project is expected to cost more than £10,000. The outcome of this process was positive. In the meantime, **it is important to note that we will need the financial assistance of parishioners for the redecoration of the Parish Church and change of the sound system. We are very grateful for your anticipated kindness and generosity.** Consequent on the redecoration of the Parish Church and change of the sound system, health and safety concerns of the parishioners, there will be some adjustments in our parish schedule which will be communicated to you in due time. The cooperation of everyone will be greatly appreciated.

MARRIAGE PAPERWORK PROCESS

You must give 6 MONTHS' NOTICE of MARRIAGE – whether it is happening HERE or ABROAD. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE. Couples or individuals should speak to a Priest VERY EARLY IN THE PROCESS – so there is no last-minute rush. Marriage Preparation Courses are NOT offered EVERY MONTH. All couples who want to do their

marriage paperwork in the parish **should contact** Fr Damian-Mary Moneke, CSSp (contact details are available on page 1).

MASS ATTENDANCE CARDS AND STICKERS

The Mass Attendance Card (**Blue colour**) (Sept 2024-Jun 2025) is for children in Year 5 and below only.

This Card will be requested by the Priest before signing of the *Certificate of Catholic Practise (CCP)* for Catholic Schools. Stickers will be given when you

- Please ensure your card has a recent PHOTO of your child and their FULL NAME.
- All parents are reminded that a sticker will only be issued if the child is present for the Mass.
- Stickers will not be given if the card is not presented. We will stop issuing stickers once the First Reading starts.
