## 25<sup>th</sup> December 2025

I wish you all a joyful and peaceful Christmas celebration and a blissful New Year!

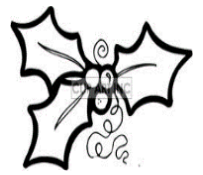
