SACRAMENTS

Confirmation 2024 - All registered candidates and their parents are required to attend an interview on Saturday 20th January at 9.30am. Parents should come along with their children's Baptism and First Holy Communion certificates if the Baptism and First Holy Communion were in a different Parish. Confirmation Day is in July.
