Keeping Advent (lots coming up!)

Advent is almost upon us! To help people go to Mass a bit more easily, during this season, we want to **temporarily move the masses on Monday and Tuesday to the evening at 6:30 PM** for Advent. This is temporary but also gives us a chance to see if this time works better for people during the week. Mass will be followed by Adoration for half hour on Monday evenings after Mass and Fr Jakub will be hosting a *Lectio Divina*, a way of engaging with the Scriptures to deepen our faith on Tuesday evenings after Mass.
