PENTECOST PARTY

The Holy Spirit united people from every country and language at Pentecost. There will be a **Pentecost Party after the 11 am Mass in the Hall on Sunday 19th May**, with teas, coffees, and food. You are invited to bring some finger food from your home country - with a flag or label. Just bring it to the hall before Mass, and place them on the tables provided. All are welcome!

11 AM MASS MUSIC

From **Pentecost Sunday**, we will phase in a more contemporary style of recorded music at the **11 am Mass**. family Mass (where more young people are likely to attend with their family). The hymns/songs may be traditional or more modern, but the style will be more contemporary. The plan is to phase this in with **two Sundays** of the more contemporary style in **June** and **two Sundays in July**. From **August onwards each 11am Sunday mass** will be exclusively a contemporary style. At our 9 am Sunday Mass, the plan is to have more traditional hymns and Mass settings, with organ accompaniment. The Saturday 6 pm Mass will have simple sung Mass settings, and no hymns.
