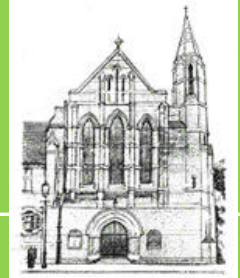
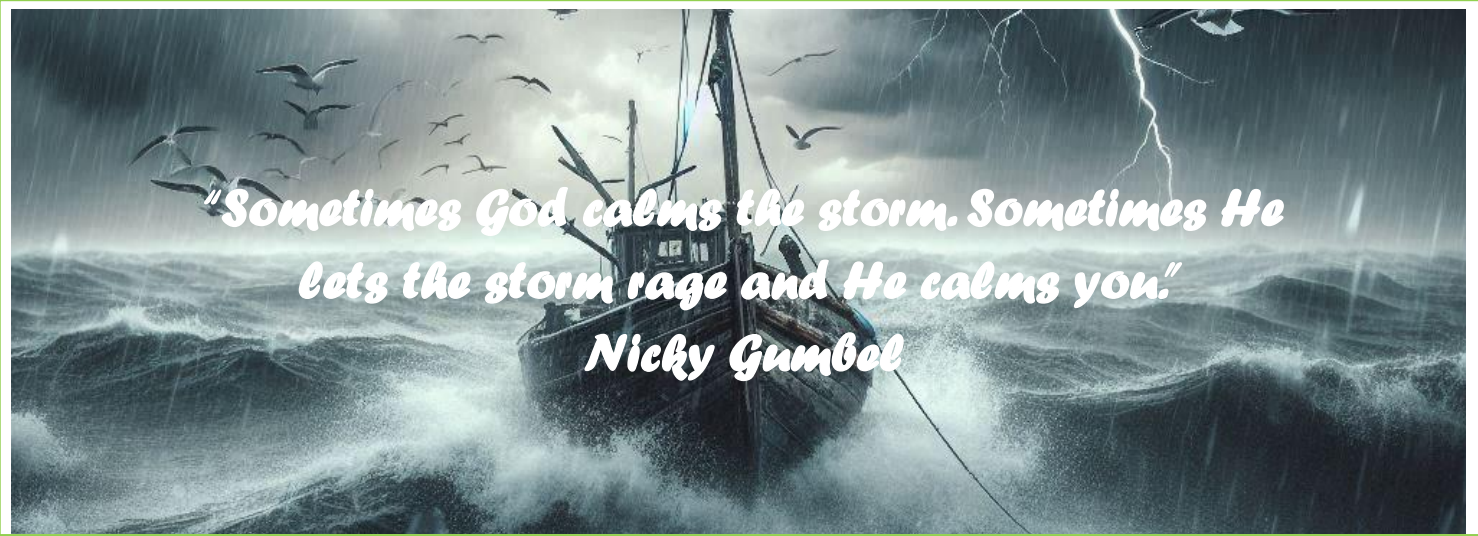

MUSIC UPDATE

The parish still has **£7,388** remaining from the **Growing in Faith (GIF)** funding that successfully installed a new church boiler over 10 years ago. The Parish Support Team (PST) and Parish Finance Committee (PFC) would like to use these remaining funds to help **develop a variety of liturgical music**. This is both to suit our own various musical preferences, and to help reach out to and draw in those who are yet to encounter Jesus. From **September 2024**, we intend to employ a **contemporary music leader** to run a project for 9 months at a cost of £10k at our 11 am Mass. The prospective leader will **play each week at the 11 am Mass**, and **support and transfer skills to future team and leaders** also during the week. The goal of the project is for the 11 am Mass to have a self-leading contemporary music team, to **help love the next generation into an encounter and relationship with Jesus**. This proposal is subject to approval from each GIF donor, who will receive an explanatory letter with an opportunity to ask questions. We hope we can get everyone's support in this exciting venture for the parish's mission to evangelise and make disciples through music.

GET READY FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

With the UK general election due on **Thursday, 4 July**, we have a responsibility as Catholics to use our vote to make

sure that parties **commit to tackling issues such as poverty, injustice and human dignity**. The Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW) offer a guide to issues for the election www.cbcew.org.uk/election24/ as do CAFOD together with the Saint Vincent de Paul Society (SVP) www.cafod.org.uk/encounter, and Caritas Social Action Network (CSAN) www.csan.org.uk/general-election-2024. These sites provide information on topics from a Catholic Christian perspective to ask key questions of local candidates. Besides, the threat of **abortion being decriminalised was averted** when this election was called, but these extreme proposals are sure to return. The next Parliament will also likely see a big push to legalise assisted suicide. It is therefore vital that **we elect MPs who will oppose these threats to life**.
