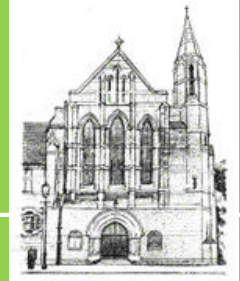

ST PETER'S ITALIAN CHURCH PROCESSION

Procession in honour of Our Lady of Mount Carmel was first held over 140 years ago. It is believed to have been the first outdoor manifestation of Roman Catholic faith since the Reformation. This year's Procession and Sagra will take place on **Sunday, 21st July** commencing at **3.30 p.m.** outside **St. Peter's Italian Church**, Clerkenwell Road EC1. Before and after the procession there is a Sagra which takes place in nearby Warner Street with food, drinks and activities.

GET READY FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION

With the UK general election due on **Thursday, 4 July**, we have a responsibility as Catholics to use our vote to make sure that parties commit to tackling issues such as poverty, injustice and human dignity. The Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW) offer a guide to issues for the election www.cbcew.org.uk/election24/ as do CAFOD together with the Saint Vincent de Paul Society (SVP) www.cafod.org.uk/encounter, and Caritas Social Action Network (CSAN) www.csan.org.uk/general-election-2024 . These sites provide information on topics from a Catholic Christian perspective to ask key questions of local candidates. Please ensure you are **registered to vote by 18 June** and have suitable Photo ID, which you will need this year.
