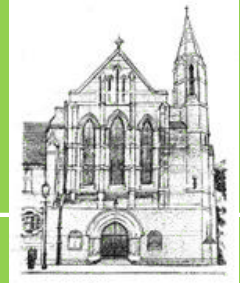

COLUMBAN FATHERS MISSION APEAL ON 31/8 AND 1/9

The Columban Fathers were founded in 1916 by two graduates of Maynooth National Seminary — Father (late Bishop) Edward Galvin and Father John Blowick. The First Mission opened in China. From the earliest years the Society of Saint Columban has had a strong presence in Britain in terms of Missionary vocations and material support, with residences in London and Birmingham. The Columbans are international and presently have missions in China, Chile, Fiji, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Peru, Pakistan, the Philippines and Taiwan. More information : www.columban.co.uk

A relic of Bl Carlo Acutis, whose Canonisation has recently been announced, will also be present.
