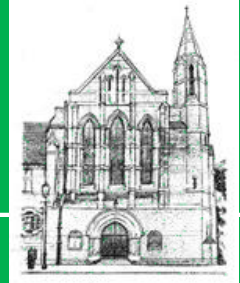

CARDINAL CALLS ON CATHOLICS TO TAKE ACTION TO OPPOSE ASSISTED SUICIDE

Cardinal Vincent Nichols, President of the Bishops' Conference, has written a pastoral letter calling on Catholics to play an active role in opposing assisted suicide. Cardinal Nichols offers three key points for Catholics to be aware of, and calls on the faithful to be fully engaged in the debate and to write to their MP to oppose assisted suicide being rushed into law.
