

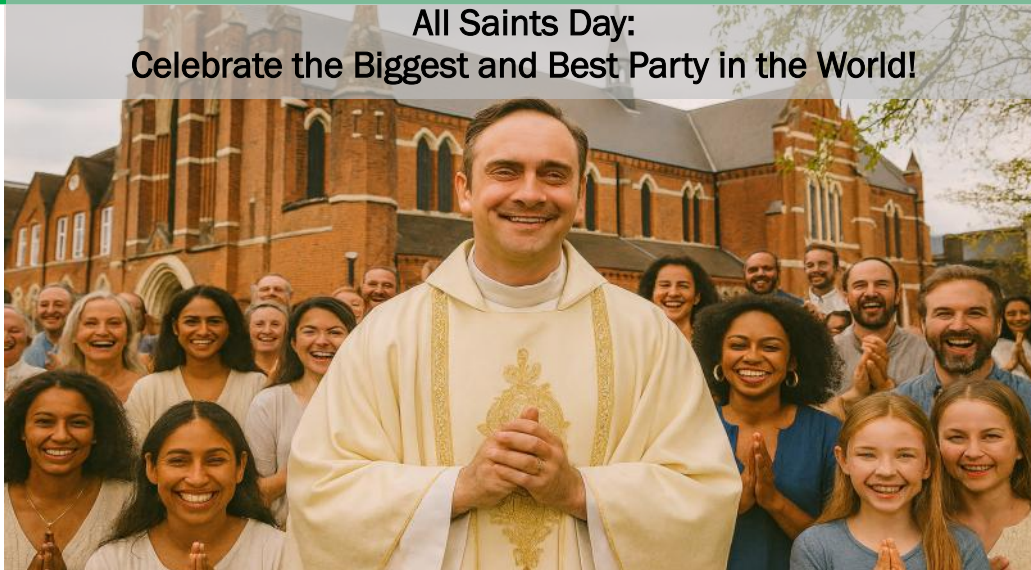

## HOLY SOULS

**November** is the month traditionally associated with **praying for the dead**. These names are placed in the Mass intentions folder for the month of November. **Masses will be prayed for the repose of their souls during this time.**
