Our Annual Novena to Our Lady of Lourdes will take place this year from February 2nd-11th. The theme of this year's

Novena is "and that people should come in procession."

This year the Novena prayers and reflections will be conducted during the 10am Mass each day beginning on **Friday 2nd February**. On Sunday February 11th, the final day of the Novena and the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes will be Celebrated during 6pm Mass followed by **Torchlight Procession** around the church **at 7pm**.

How often do we meet people whose words and deeds match? Sometimes at least, but it may be rare enough. In the old expression, when all is said and done, more is said than done. Jesus is

a teacher with authority — not the authority of position or force but power from within. This is suggested

by the Greek word for authority exousia, from within (my) being. Even today, there are religious leaders who speak from within, whose word is genuine, whose deeds match what they say. These are the one we listen to; these are the ones we would love to be like.
