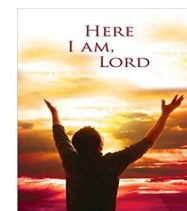

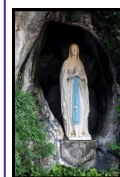

Celebrated during 6pm Mass followed
by **Torchlight Procession** around the
church at 7pm.

our Novena and placed

5th Sunday of the Year Thought for the day

Today we continue to read from
Mark's Gospel, learning more about
the ministry of Jesus. Jesus cured
Simon's mother-in-law, just as he also
cured, many others who were brought
to him, healing their illnesses.

Jesus' compassion and healing of the
sick, is a sign of the Kingdom of God.

The Church continues to extend
Christ's healing presence, to others
in its ministry, to the sick.

In the Sacrament of the Anointing
of the Sick, the Church prays for
spiritual and physical healing,
forgiveness of sins, and comfort for
those who are suffering from illness.

In today's Gospel we also notice the
importance of prayer in Jesus'
daily life. Jesus rose early
in the morning, removed himself from
the crowds, and went to a deserted
place to pray. When the disciples
found him, he told them that it was
time to move on. No doubt in his
prayers Jesus found guidance and
direction from God. For ourselves too,
we can bring our decision-making to
God in prayer, drawing him into our
decision-making, asking for his
guidance and direction in our lives.
