## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

We are currently in the second week of Lent, and we are presented powerful and undeniable truths. Witnessing Abraham's unwavering obedience to God in the Book of Genesis, even when tasked with sacrificing his beloved son, Isaac is a testament to God's power and authority. Mount Moriah, where this sacrifice took place, would become the site where God would send His Son to be sacrificed for our salvation.

St. Paul boldly proclaims that Christ's suffering and death have redeemed us, reconciling us to God and fulfilling His everlasting Covenant.

The Transfiguration of the Lord, where His Divine Glory is revealed to His disciples, confirms His divine nature and mission.
