FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT We are currently in the fifth week

of Lent. In the first reading, God assures the people of Israel that He will make a covenant with them if they obey Him. He promises to make them worthy of writing the covenant in their hearts. In the second reading, we learn that Jesus obeyed God and saved humanity from sin. In the Gospel, we are told that unless a grain of wheat obeys the earth and dies, it will just remain a grain. But if it dies, it will grow and produce plenty of fruit. The grain doesn't actually die, but it is transformed into something completely new, roots, leaves, and more fruitful grains. Dying to oneself is a blessing for others. Jesus says, "Anyone who clings to his life will lose it."
