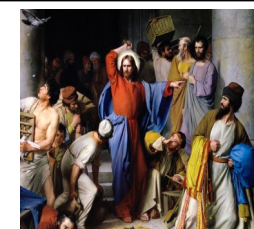

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

On the third Sunday of Lent, we are reminded of the Ten Commandments and the importance of living a life in accordance with them. In addition, St. Paul explains why the Jews failed to understand Jesus, highlighting the need for us to approach our faith with an open heart and mind. When Jesus enters the temple and is angered by its desecration, it serves as a reminder to us of the sacredness of our places of worship.

We can use the Commandments to guide us towards greater repentance and to help us give back to God. As the temples of the Holy Spirit, we must work to cleanse our hearts of negativity and harmful behaviours. Let us welcome Jesus into our lives through repentance and renewal, and use our parish church as a place to come together in love and gratitude to praise God.

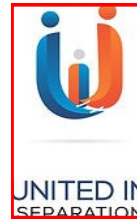

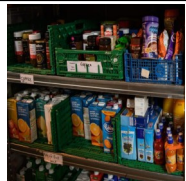
