Blessing of religious objects and Veneration at the end of Mass followed by tea and coffee at back of Church. All Welcome.

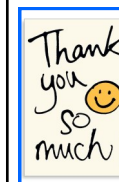


## The Season of Easter

Your generous act of bringing **Easter flowers** to both churches is truly inspiring. Thank you for spreading joy and happiness.



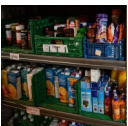
