FROM THE PRESBYTERY WINDOW

READINGS

First Reading: Wisdom 2:12. 17-20;

Let us condemn him to a shameful death.

Responsorial Psalm 53; The Lord upholds my life.

Second Reading: St James 3:16-4:3;

Peacemakers, when they work for peace, sow seeds which will bear fruit in holiness.

Gospel: Mark 9:30-37: The Son of Man will be delivered. If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself servant of all.

PRAYING WITH THE POPE: "THE HEART OF THE CHURCH'S MISSION IS PRAYER".

The Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network (formerly known as the Apostleship of Prayer) run by the Jesuits (SJ) encourages all to participate. Each month the Pope's monthly prayer intention is offered to the whole People of God. In September, Pope Francis asks; "We pray we will make courageous choices for a simple & environmentally sustainable lifestyle, rejoicing in our young people who are resolutely committed to this." When Pope Francis invites us to pray with him for a specific intention, he asks us to take on this mission which must have prayer at its heart. This is how to approach September's timely Intention. Clearly, our prayer leads to action and can never be an excuse for avoiding it!

Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me .

O God, who founded all the commands of your sacred Law upon love of you and of our neighbour, grant that, by keeping your precepts, we may merit to attain eternal life.

Our readings speak about wisdom, but from different perspectives. The reading from Wisdom can be seen as a prophecy of the Lord's Passion. The 'godless' regard with contempt those who listen to and follow God's voice, condemning them to cruel death. The Psalm also speaks of those who have no regard for God. Seeking God's protection from surrounding threats, the psalmist prays with certainty: 'I have God for my help. The Lord upholds my life.' James points out jealousy and ambition cause division and rivalry, in contrast to the wisdom coming from above.

Such wisdom, which desires humility and not glory, brings us peace with ourselves and can be attained through prayer. It is 'essentially something pure, it's kindly and considerate; it's full of compassion and shows itself by doing good.' Jesus predicts his own death and resurrection with the disciples, who fail to understand what this means. They have been arguing which of them is the greatest, but Jesus teaches them true greatness lies in being the servant of all, especially the weak and the helpless. He symbolizes this by embracing the child and places the child in their midst. By welcoming and serving 'little children' we are welcoming God.

We ask for the wisdom to see Christ in all the 'little children' we encounter and pray for a spirit of humility and peace. **Fr Jimmy**
