# 5th March 2023 Second Sunday of Lent Year A

#### God has saved us by his own grace

Our readings encourage us to think about our journey of faith in the company of the transfigured Lord, and the importance of trusting in the call and grace of God our Father. Genesis recounts God's astonishing call to Abram to abandon his land, his family and his nation, and Abram's generous response. With divine blessing and guidance, Abram, who becomes Abraham, finds a new home and a new life, serving as an example to us. Paul makes it clear we are called to a holiness not of our making, but God's. Like Timothy, we are reminded we are not alone. We're invited to rely on divine power and grace revealed by the life and death of Christ Jesus. Like Abraham, we too, must learn to live by trusting in God's grace and God's calling of us. Trust in God the Father is exemplified above all in the life of Jesus, who is shown transfigured on the mountain top, radiant with divine light. The Father proclaims Jesus as his Beloved Son and adds the important invitation, 'Listen to him'. Psalm 32 meditates on the creative power of the Lord, encouraging us to put our trust in the Lord who fills the earth with his love. We pray for a deepening personal relationship with Christ Jesus; for the grace to listen to his voice, hear his call to personal ministry and feel his presence in our daily lives. We pray too, for peace in our troubled world.

No such council has met since well before the covid days. The feeling was that it might be worth reviving the PPC to support the community and spiritual life of all our parishioners, working closely with Father Jimmy. We need to decide more clearly what a PPC would do. Might it:

- Coordinate and support current groups in the parish – choirs, sacramental preparation, readers etc?

- Coordinate and support parish community meetings – regular coffee mornings, occasional parish events?

- Reach out better to different groups in the parish – young people, sick and elderly, other needy groups or local charities, those who for whatever reason find it difficult to attend mass?

Support the spiritual needs of parishioners?
Support a more real engagement with the Westminster diocese.

And there will be many other ideas that parishioners have – as shared during the synodal process last year.

The Parish meetings felt that the role of a PPC is best decided through one or two consultations with parishioners.
