Paul stresses to the Romans, in Baptism we die to our old selves and are reborn to a new life with Christ. Jesus continues to instruct his disciples by reminding the following him will not always be easy, but it will have its own rewards or blessings. Whether we welcome a prophet, a holy person or the smallest 'little one', a good deed, even the simplest cup of water, will not go unnoticed. In welcoming others, we welcome the Lord himself. We might want to reflect on the way we and our society welcomes those who must leave their own land and settle in a new country.
